1. Project Overview

Partners For Quality is a nonprofit organization comprised of five subsidiary agencies that support individuals with intellectual & developmental disabilities and behavioral health challenges. Our family of agencies provide programs and services ranging from community living residences and supported employment to mental health and substance use counseling. In all, our nonprofit organizations proudly support more than 4,000 people in Western Pennsylvania. Partners For Quality administrative services include finance, human resources, information technology, development, communications and staff training. By consolidating and overseeing these services, our subsidiaries can focus on their top priority: the people they support.

Partners For Quality and its subsidiaries occupy an administrative building located in Robinson Township, Allegheny County. With continued expansion of services and support for people with intellectual & developmental disabilities and behavioral health there is a need to build out three sections of the building and modernize the current meeting room.

Partners For Quality is requesting proposals from qualified architectural firms to provide comprehensive design for the renovation of three (3) floors and the modernization of a meeting room within its existing building located at 250 Clever Road, McKees Rocks, PA 15136, which is owned by Partners For Quality.

This renovation project will modernize 3,000 square feet in a current meeting room and build out 12,000 square feet of interior space to support office operations and a commercial kitchen. The selected architect will be responsible for assessing current building conditions and delivering design solutions that maximize functionality, meet applicable codes, and align with the organization's vision and budget.

2. Project Scope

The scope of services will include, but is not limited to:

- Site and building evaluation
- Programming and space planning
- Schematic and design development
- Code compliance analysis (ADA, fire, life safety, etc.)
- Preparation of construction documents
- Permitting coordination
- Bidding and contractor selection assistance
- Project closeout and as-built documentation

The renovation will involve:

- Mechanical, electrical, and plumbing (MEP) upgrades
- Fire protection and life safety improvements
- Accessibility and energy efficiency enhancements


