Steel City Duck Derby (Saturday)

Ten thousand rubber ducks hit the water for the fifth annual Steel City Duck Derby at Allegheny Commons Park on the North Side.

The fundraiser for Partners For Quality features a Family Duck Fest beginning at 11 a.m. with music, games, face painting and more, emceed by 3WS morning host Jonny Hartwell.

Food trucks will include Affordable Elegance, Allegheny City Brewing, Bruster's of Hopewell, Fat Cat Mac Attack, Franken-Fried, Pappy's Gourmet Popcorn, The Oven Pizza Company, The Roaming Bean Coffee, Twisted Lemonades and Yovi's Hot Dogs.

It's followed by the race through Lake Elizabeth at 1 p.m. The top five finishers will win prizes, with the first place winner taking home \$2,000.
